General Information

ADMISSION

Admission to the Royal Australian Mint is free.

FRONT DESK

The Front Desk is located on the ground level. A Visitor Experience Host will be present there to assist you with any questions you have about your visit. Children's activity books and visitor maps are available here.

WHEELCHAIRS

If you require a wheelchair, please ask one of our Visitor Experience Hosts who will happily assist you. Additionally, if you'd like to book a wheelchair in advance, please contact us on 6202 6999 and ask for the Education and Visitor Services team.

SAFETY FOR CHILDREN

- Footwear must be worn at all times.
- No scooters or bicycles in the exhibition area (mobility scooters exempt).
- Do not leave any bags or personal possessions unattended.
We do not have a cloakroom, however, you are welcome to take bags into the gallery space.
- Children under the age of 15 must be supervised at all times.

ACCESSIBILITY

Accessible parking is available.
Lifts available in the Visitor Gallery.

ACCESSIBILITY TIPS

- Braille booklets are available.
- Our visitor gallery and foyer have fluorescent lighting.
- Guide and service animals welcome.
- If at any stage you need a quiet place to go, please ask one of our Visitor Experience Hosts who will happily help you find a suitable space.

Social Story

This story has information about what you can expect during your visit to the Mint.

1. ENTRANCE



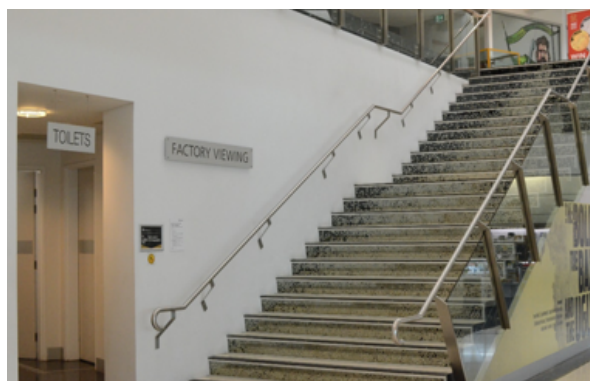
The Mint is on Denison Street in Deakin ACT. You will walk up a ramp and come through these doors to get into the Mint.

2. FOYER/FRONT DESK



You will be greeted at the Front Desk by a Visitor Experience Host. If you'd like, you can ask them for an activity book or visitor map of the Mint. The Host will also explain what you can do during your visit, and where you will be able to find things. Visitor Experience Hosts will be wearing uniforms like this. Feel free to ask them any questions during your visit.

3. COIN CASCADE STAIRCASE



This staircase is the entrance to the Visitor Gallery and Factory Viewing Area. You can use this staircase to get into the Visitor Gallery or you can take the lift. There is a toilet to the left of the staircase if you need it.

4. THEATRETTE



The Theatrette is at the top of the staircase.

5. CHILDREN'S CORNER



There will be activities in this corner if you'd like to join in. There will be a Visitor Experience Host here to help you.

6. GALLERY



The stairs or lift will take you to the Visitor Gallery. You can view the exhibitions, or ask our Visitor Experience Host questions.

7. FACTORY VIEWING



After the Visitor Gallery or Children's Corner, you can enter the Factory Viewing Area to look into the factory where our coins are made. You will be able to look into the Proof Room, Tool Room and Circulating Coin Hall.

8. SHOP



You can then head back down the stairs or lift to do some shopping if you'd like. The Coin Shop Staff will be behind the counter ready to assist you with your purchase.

9. COIN PRESS



You can also strike a brand new coin in the Shop. Bring \$3 worth of coins with you if you'd like to try this. The Shop Staff can also help if you need assistance.

10. EXIT



When you are ready to head home, you can exit the Mint the same way you came in.
