

# Back of House Tour Entry

## Terms and Conditions

1. This Competition is being conducted by the **Royal Australian Mint** (Mint) (ABN 45 852 104 259) 62 – 114 Denison Street, Deakin ACT 2600, (“**Promoter**”).
2. The Promoter is offering the opportunity for visitors to the Mint to enter the “**2026 Family Fun Day Back of House Tour**” competition to go into the running to win one (1) prize.
3. By entering the Competition, the Entrant accepts and agrees to abide by these Terms and Conditions. Information regarding prizes and how to enter forms part of these conditions.

### How to Enter

4. Entry to the Competition is open all visitors onsite at the Mint.
5. The Promotion: Family Fun Day Back of House Tours – Saturday 28 February 2026
6. To enter the Competition, an Entrant must be onsite at the Royal Australian Mint during the Promotional Period. 62 – 114 Denison St, Deakin ACT 2600. Saturday 28 February 2026 9:00am – 2:00pm.
7. Five (5) winners will be identified on **the day**.
8. Each of the five (5) winners can bring one (1) immediate family member, the one (1) winner and one (1) other family member.

### Restrictions on Entry

9. The directors, management and employees (and their immediate families, including children and wards, and other persons residing in their household, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or first cousin) of the Promoter, its related entities, distributors, printers, suppliers, providers and agencies associated with the Competition are ineligible to enter the Competition.
10. Entrants can only enter the competition once.
11. All winners and accompanying immediate family member **MUST** wear solid strong fully enclosed footwear.
12. Winners and accompanying immediate family member will be provided with personal protection equipment (PPE) required during the tour. Eye wear, high-visibility vest and hearing protection.
13. No bags, mobile phones, prams, photography or coins to be taken on the tour.
14. An age limit of eight (8) years and above applies.
15. All guests eight years to 16 years inclusive **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18 years.
16. The Mint has an official photographer to take pictures through the tour and will email them within 14 days after the event.

17. Due to environmental sensitives, including dust, hair and chemicals, we are unable to accommodate animals within this area (including service animals).
18. All winners and immediate family must sign a condition of entry form prior to entering the Back of House area.
19. All winners and immediate family members **MUST** follow the direction given by Mint staff and security.
20. All winners and immediate family members **MUST** consent to going through a security screening process on exiting the Back of House area.

### Prizes

21. **11:30am - Family Fun Day Back of House tour:** Five (5) eligible entrants and one (1) immediate family member will each receive an entry to a guided Family Fun Day Back of House Tour.
22. **2:30pm - Family Fun Day Back of House tour:** Five (5) eligible entrants and one (1) immediate family member will each receive an entry to a guided Family Fun Day Back of House Tour.
23. There is no cost to enter the prize draw. The Promoter is neither responsible nor liable for any change in the prize value occurring between the publishing date and the date a prize is claimed. The prize value is in Australian dollars.

### Eligibility for Prizes

24. For an entrant to be eligible for the prizes, the entrant must:
25. Be onsite during the promotional period.
26. A person may only enter the competition **ONCE**.
27. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that they have met all eligibility requirements.

### Conditions of Each Prize

#### Family Fun Day Back of House Tours

28. Five (5) winners of the Family Fun Day Back of House tours will be selected by an impartial draw on Saturday 28 February 2026 from the total pool of entrants (onsite).
29. The winners of the 2026 Family Fun Day Back of House Tours will be announced on that day.

### Adjudication of Prizes

30. Numbered wristbands will be placed on visitors' wrists by Mint Staff as proof of entry with the correlating number placed into the raffle barrel.
31. 2026 Family Fun Day 11:30am Back of House Tour will be drawn from 11:00am Saturday 28 February 2026. Entries will be randomly pulled from the barrel with numbers being called. The number will be called three

- (3) times within a one (1) minute time frame, if no one has identified with that number then there will be a redraw until a winner is found. Winning wrist band numbers will be recorded against the number you were drawn for and filed accordingly.
32. 2026 Family Fun Day 2:30pm Back of House Tour will be drawn from 2:00pm Saturday 28 February 2026. Entries will be randomly pulled from the barrel with numbers being called. The number will be called three (3) times within a one (1) minute time frame, if no one has identified with that number then there will be a redraw until a winner is found. Winning wrist band numbers will be recorded against the number you were drawn for and filed accordingly.
33. All entries from the first draw at 11:00am will stay in the barrel and remain valid for the second draw at 2:00pm.

### Responsibility and Liability of the Promoter

34. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for visitors late to the event.
35. Unless expressly stated within these Terms and Conditions, or as otherwise provided by the Promoter, all expenses are the responsibility of the entrants.
36. The Promoter is not responsible in any manner whatsoever for any problems or any financial costs incurred, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to participants or any other persons related to or resulting from participation in this competition.
37. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage suffered (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving, taking or using any prizes, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. The Promoter's liability in all cases will be limited to the value of the relevant prizes.
38. Any attempt, deliberate or otherwise, to cause malicious damage or interference with the normal functioning of the Competition, undermine the legitimate operation of the Competition may be a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should an attempt be made, whether successful or not, the Promoter reserves the right to seek damages to the fullest extent permitted by law. If the Promoter suffers loss or incurs any costs in connection with any breach of these Terms and Conditions or any other legal obligation by an entrant, the entrant agrees to indemnify the Promoter for these losses, damages and costs.

### Variation and Cancellation

39. No responsibility or liability is accepted for any variation to the prizes. In the event that any prize is unavailable, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute a different prize of equal or greater value subject to any written directions from the various state authorities.
40. Subject to the relevant authority approval, if required, the Promoter reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions of this Competition at any time.
41. Subject to the relevant authority approval, if required, the Promoter reserves the right to vary the Prize with a prize of equal or greater value.
42. Subject to the relevant authority approval, if required, the Promoter reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, at any time before the awarding of the prizes to cancel the Competition or to vary or cancel the award of a prize including, without limitation, circumstances

where in the Promoter's opinion (which it shall form in its absolute discretion):

- a. a winner does not satisfy the Competition entry requirements; or
  - b. the Promoter cannot conduct the Competition or award the prizes for any reason beyond its control.
43. Subject to relevant authority approval, if required, if the Promoter cancels the Competition or varies or withdraws a prize it shall not:
- a. be liable to any person for any loss or damage (including loss or damage caused by any negligence) arising out of, or in connection with, such cancellation, variation or withdrawal; and
  - b. be required to conduct the Competition at any other time.

### Privacy Statement

44. The Promoter will collect the winning entrants' personal information to conduct the competition. If the information requested is not provided, the entrant will forfeit their opportunity to claim a prize. The promoter is bound by the Privacy Act 1988M (Cth).
45. As a condition of entry into the Competition, an entrant consents to, in the event they are the winner or not, the Promoter using the entrant's name, likeness and image (including photograph/film) in any media for an unlimited period of time without further notification, remuneration or compensation for the purpose of promoting, publicising or marketing the Competition. The entrant agrees that, in the event they are the winner, the entrant will participate in all reasonable promotional activities in relation to the Competition as requested by the Promoter and its agents and sign any additional documents reasonably required by the Promoter to give effect to this condition.
